He studied Economics at St. Stephens College, Delhi University and at the Delhi School of Economics. He went on to do his MBA from the Yale School of Management, USA.

Rajeev is the President of the Employers' Federation of India (EFI), serves on the CII National Committee of Leadership and HR, CII Apex Council on Affirmative Action, and is Co-Chairman of the CII National Committee on Skills Development. He is also a member of the National Executive Committee of FICCI and serves on the Boards of Walchand Talent First, the Lal Bahadur Shastri Institute of Management and Technology (LBSIMT), the School of Inspired Leadership (SOIL) and Magic Bus – an NGO that works with underprivileged youth.
